

**BELOIT MEN'S AND WOMEN'S BOWLING

YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP**

The Beloit Men's and Women's Bowling Associations will award scholarships to graduating high school students. A scholarship committee will consist of representatives from the bowling centers, the Men's Secretary, Women's President, a member of the academic community, Dave Cliffe and Bonnie Rayner, Scholarship Committee Secretary/Treasurer. Scholarship funds will be sent to the college or school of higher learning that the recipient is attending. The funds will be paid upon proof of registration verified by letter of acceptance from the institution at the discretion of the committee. Funds may vary from year to year based on availability.

ELIGIBILITY RULES:

1. Must be a graduating high school senior.
2. Is currently a USBC Youth member and actively bowling in a certified league within the Greater Beloit Area.
3. Applicant must have a good record with AJBC/YABA in bowling and WIAA or IIAA in high school activities.
4. Application must be filled out in a concise orderly manner with complete information as required before APRIL 1.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. Form #1 - APPLICANT'S PERSONAL DATA must be completed and returned with a typewritten, 250 or more word theme on "How Bowling Has Influenced me and How This Scholarship Will Affect My Future".
2. FORM #2 - BOWLING INFORMATION and provided envelope for form #2 must be given to the coach for completion. Form #2 must be signed and returned to the applicant in the sealed envelope.
3. FORM #3 - HIGH SCHOOL DATA and provided envelope for form #3 must be given to your advisor, counselor or principal for completion. Form #3 must be signed and returned to the applicant in the sealed envelope.

IMPORTANT: The Applicant will be solely responsible to mail all information, such as: Form #1, Form #2, Form #3 and the 250 word typewritten theme to DAVID CLIFFE by April 1 in one envelope.

**All data forms are to be mailed by APRIL 1 in one envelope.
Applications received postmarked after APRIL 1 will be disregarded.**
