Instructions to Applicant – please be sure entire application is legible.

ELIGIBILITY RULES (Please read entire application carefully)

Any graduating high school senior is eligible to receive a scholarship, providing the student meets the following requirements:

- A. The recipient(s) must be a graduating high school senior planning to attend an accredited secondary learning institution. (This includes any public or private university, junior or state college, technical institute or any specialized trade school.)
- B. Files an application furnished by the Wisconsin Women's Bowling Scholarship Committee, with complete information by the **MARCH 1ST DEADLINE**. Application to be filed with the Wisconsin State USBC Women's Bowling Association at the address below.
- C. Has unimpaired amateur standing in all athletics.
- D. Is a member of a league certified by the United States Bowling Congress boundaries of the Wisconsin State USBC Women's Bowling Association and is in good standing for the current season.
- E. Has a 2.0 or better grade point average at the close of Semester 1 of the senior year. (GPA based on A-4.0, B-3.0, C-2.0).

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Step #1 - Fill out part I entirely. Be sure to sign application.

Step #2 - Have your Youth coach fill out part II entirely.

Step #3 - Have a school official or your school counselor fill out part III.

Step #4 - Compose an essay of at least 150 words telling of your specific college choice, future plans and how bowling activities will help you to achieve your goals. Essay must be typewritten.

Step #5 - Mail the application and the essay to the address below by the **MARCH 1ST DEADLINE**.
